REPEAL OF ALL OLD ORDINANCES TOWNSHIP OF COLFAX, MICHIGAN Ord. No. 1 Effective August 12, 1982

An ordinance repealing any and all old ordinances previously made in the Township of Colfax for the Township of Colfax.

THE TOWNSHIP OF COLFAX ORDAINS:

Section 1:

All old ordinances previously made in and for the Township of Colfax are repealed.

REGULATIONS FOR THE TOWNSHIP PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE PUBLIC BEACH AREA AT SCHOOL SECTION LAKE TOWNSHIP OF COLFAX OCEANA COUNTY, MICHIGAN Ord. No. 2 effective September 13, 1982

An ordinance establishing regulations for the beach area.

THE TOWNSHIP OF COLFAX ORDAINS:

Section 1. No person or persons shall within the township beach area:

- (a). Maliciously destroy, damage, deface or remove any township beach property.
 - (b). Use sound equipment to be heard more than 100 feet from such equipment after 12:00 midnight.
 - (c). Drive any vehicle on beach or in water of swimming, picnic, or play area.
 - (d). Operate a motor driven boat in the swimming area.
 - (e). Build or maintain a fire of wood or charcoal except in picnic area.
 - (f). Be a disorderly person by doing any of the following:
 - (1). being intoxicated and endangering directly the safety of another person or property.
 - (2). engaging in indecent or obscene conduct.
 - (3). making or exciting a public disturbance.
 - (4). unnecessarily jostling or crowding people.
 - (g). Deposit refuse or waste material which has originated outside the township property.
 - (h). Deposit waste material except in designated receptacles, or set fire to the contents of a refuse barrel.
 - (i). Have any horses.
 - (j). Have a dog except on a leash.
 - (k). Use, possess or deliver any alcoholic beverages or controlled substances.
 - (l). Have guns or other weapons.
 - (m). Possess or use a glass container in any area.

Section 2. Any person or persons found guilty of having violated this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to a fine of not to exceed \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not to exceed 90 days.

Section 3. If any portion of this Ordinance shall be declared to be illegal or unconstitutional, the remaining portions of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days following its adoption and publications.

REGULATIONS FOR THE TOWNSHIP PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE COLFAX TOWNSHIP CEMETERY

TOWNSHIP OF COLFAX, OCEANA COUNTY, MICHIGAN Ord. No. 3 effective Sept. 13, 1982

An ordinance establishing regulations for the Colfax Township Cemetery.

THE TOWNSHIP OF COLFAX ORDAINS:

Section 1. No person or persons shall within the Colfax Cemetery:

- (a). Maliciously destroy, damage, deface, move or remove any township property or cemetery fixtures.
 - (b). Be a disorderly person by doing any of the following:
 - (1). being intoxicated and endangering directly the safety of another person or property.
 - (2). engaging in indecent or obscene conduct.
 - (3). making or exciting a public disturbance.
 - (4). unnecessarily jostling or crowding people.
 - (c). Deposit refuse or waste material.
 - (d). Have any animals, except by permission of the Township Board.
 - (e). Use, possess or deliver any alcoholic beverages or controlled substances.
 - (f). Have guns or other weapons, except by permission of the Township Board.
 - (g). Use a glass container.
 - (h). Loiter.
 - (i). Use a radio, sound equipment, or make any excessive noise, except by permission of the Township Board.
 - (j). Have a picnic or any other party function.

Section 2. Any person or persons found guilty of having violated this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to a fine of not to exceed \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not to exceed 90 days.

Section 3. If any portion of this Ordinance shall be declared to be illegal or unconstitutional, the remaining portions of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days following its adoption and publications.

The foregoing Ordinance was introduced by the Township Board on July 6, 1982 and adopted on August 3, 1982.

Section 4. The Colfax Township Board assumes the right and responsibility of setting up rules and regulations for the use of the Colfax Township Cemetery as the Board sees fit, subject to the laws of the state of Michigan. The following is a list of the regulations:

- (a). All spreading shrubs and flowers are to be removed from the cemetery.
- (b). A family monument may be placed and maintained at the family's expense.
- (c). Individual monuments or markers are to be placed no higher than ground level.
- (d). Potted plants and cut flowers may be placed on graves, but will be removed upon their wilting or dying.
- (e). Grass sod will be maintained as much as possible.
- (f). A minimum of three grass cuttings will be maintained each year.
- (g). Leaves are to be raked and destroyed before Memorial Day of each year.
