Resolution made at annual budget meeting held on March, 11, 2026 at Colfax Township Hall

WHEREAS, it is recognized that election workers provide a vital role in township government and democracy in general.

WHEREAS, it is also recognized that a competitive compensation rate is advantageous in recruiting competent workers and a pool of workers that allows the township to effectively perform this essential role.

WHEREAS, it is recognized that no increase in election worker pay rate has transpired in at least two (2) fiscal years.

LASTLY, It is imperative that Colfax Township election workers are compensated at a wage consistent with election workers at countywide early voting locales.

THEREFORE, HEREBY BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The hourly wage be increased to \$20 per hour worked for all Colfax election workers with the election Chairperson to earn \$20.50 per hour.
2. These hourly wages are effective for FY 2027-27 beginning April 1, 2026 and are to remain in effect from that date forward, or unless repealed or modified by the Colfax Township Board.
